# FOLLOWING ARE SOME OF THE GUIDELINES TO BE FOLLOWED FOR THE VARIOUS COMPETITIONS.

We the organizer would like to request the Head of the Department or Head of the Institute to send maximum number of ten students and one faculty (optional) for the said program. 'Food and accommodation will be provided by the host. We request each college to confirm the number of participants for both male and female at the earliest.

- 1. All the colleges are requested to participate in all the competitions.
- 2. There will be registration fee of rupees 200 per head.
- 3. Registration will be done on the spot.
- 4. There is no registration fee for any of the competition except the E-Games.
- 5. Cash prize and certificate will be given to the winners.

# COMPETITION AND ITS CRITERIA

#### 1. Solo Dance Competition

- a. There should be one minimum participant from each participating institute.
- b. The dance style can be of any form.
- c. The maximum performing time will be of 2-5 minute.

## 2. Solo Singing Competition

- a. There should be one participant from each college.
- b. No instrument will be provided for the participants.
- c. Participant may accompany one musician if he/she is not able to use music instrument for him/herself.
- d. Karaoke is allowed.

# 3. Street Play

- a. The street play would be based on the theme of the fest.
- b. The time limit for the performance will be 7 minutes with 10 participants only.

# 4. Video Making

- a. Pre-Recorded video will be presented on the fest with the theme of "Shared future for transformative change"
- b. There is no limit of participants for pre-recorded video.
- c. The video should be recorded with maximum of 8 minutes.

#### 5. Debate

- a. Topic: **Impact of Westernization** (Northeastern perspective)
- b. There should be 2 participants from every participating team.
- c. The 'for and against the motion' group will be known only during the competition, so requesting all the participants to kindly be prepared with both for and against the motion.

#### 6. Painting

- a. The painting will be based on the theme "Together we thrive"
- b. Participation is kept open.
- c. The participants should bring their own painting materials.

#### 7. Model Presentation

- a. The theme for model presentation is on "Technology for good"
- b. The number of participants is maximum five.
- c. They can either bring pre-made model or they can come and prepare from the campus, place Will be provided by the host for preparation.
- d. The competitors have to bring their materials for model presentation.

#### 8. Beat Box:

- a. Participation is kept open for all participating institute.
- b. The maximum performing time will be of 3 minutes.
- c. Open across all gender.

#### 9. Photography:

- a. Photography will be based on the theme "Capturing connections"
- b. Open for all.
- c. The photo must be in its original state (No editing)
