## GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACT

1. The abstract should be in 250 words with five key words
2. The APA style 7th edition is to be followed for citation and references
3. The language to be used is English
4. The font size is 12 with Times New Roman style and 1.5 as line spacing
5. The full name, designation, phone number with WhatsApp, email address, institutional affiliation and a passport size photo are to be included at the time of abstract submission
6. The abstract will undergo peer review and the author will be contacted regarding the rejection or modification or acceptance
7. If the abstract is accepted one has to fill the registration fees and make payments and send the full papers.
8. The full paper requires to be within the word limit of 4000 to the minimum and 5000 to the maximum
