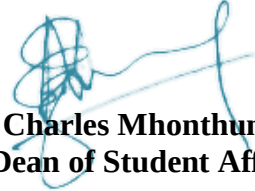

3. Eligibility to contest the election for the various posts of the Student Council;

- Must be an enrolled regular student of this institute.
- Must secure 80% attendance in the previous as well as current Attendance Assessment.
- Must not have any Backlog of Paper/Papers as of date.
- Must not have any negative comment/s against him/her in the area of discipline.
- Must not indulge in any form of tribal/communal campaign or conduct.
- Must abide by the prescribed method of campaign. No classroom campaigning or gathering, candidates cannot promise any policy or act which would deviate or contravene the laid down rules and regulations of this University.

4. Special Criteria for contesting the election to certain Post: To refer the Constitution of SJUSC

The violation of any of the above criteria will result in immediate dis-qualification from contesting in the election to any post of the students' body.

5. On Polling day all eligible voters must produce their University Identity Card. For the newly admitted students, they must produce their Admission Card.

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
