ABOLITION OF UNIFORM FOR POST GRADUATE STUDENTS

This is to notify to all the Post-Graduate students of St Joseph University that starting from 2025 even semester, the rules & regulations governing the dress code for the Post-Graduate (PG) students have been modified according to the following instructions mentioned below:

1. **The current dress code for the PG students have been changed such that there is no longer any colour regulation for both male and female PG students, which is defined in terms of 'uniform' dress code.**
2. **However, even though the uniform dress code has been abolished for the PG students, certain basic parameters must be observed.**
 - i. **The dress pattern should be decent, avoiding shorts, sleeveless or revealing dresses.**
 - ii. **Male students should wear long pants, irrespective of the cloth material.**
 - iii. **Female students should avoid short dresses, such as miniskirts or micro-mini skirts and sleeveless tops or dress.**
 - iv. **T-Shirts are also allowed but must have collar, which includes the departmental T-Shirts.**
 - v. **Wearing of shoes is compulsory as well as display of the identity card. If any student fails to display their identity card he or she will be penalized.**
