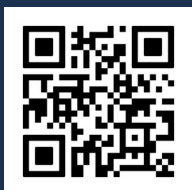

Abstract: 250–300 words, clearly stating objectives, methodology, key findings, and significance. Keywords: 4–6 relevant keywords. Full-paper: 4000-7000 words.
