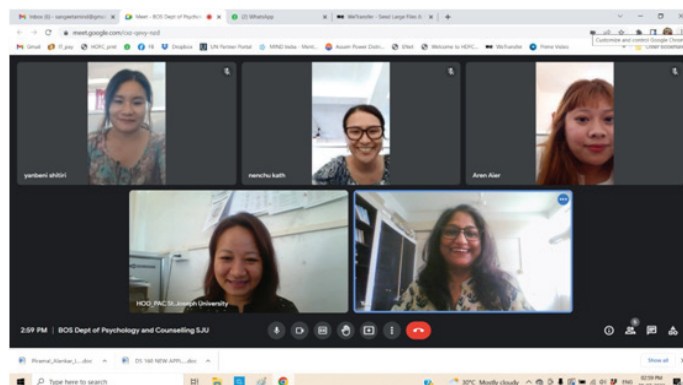

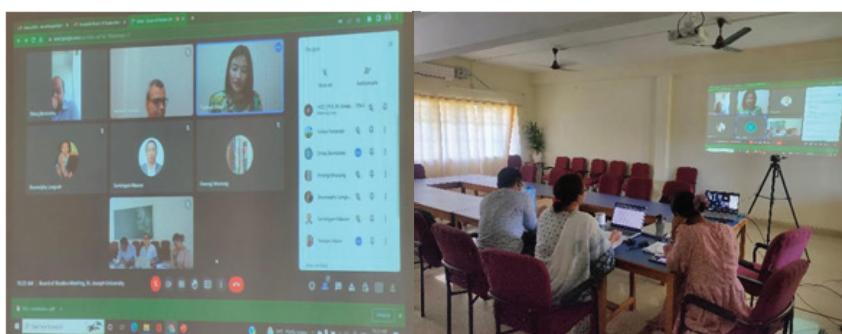

INDUCTION PROGRAMS



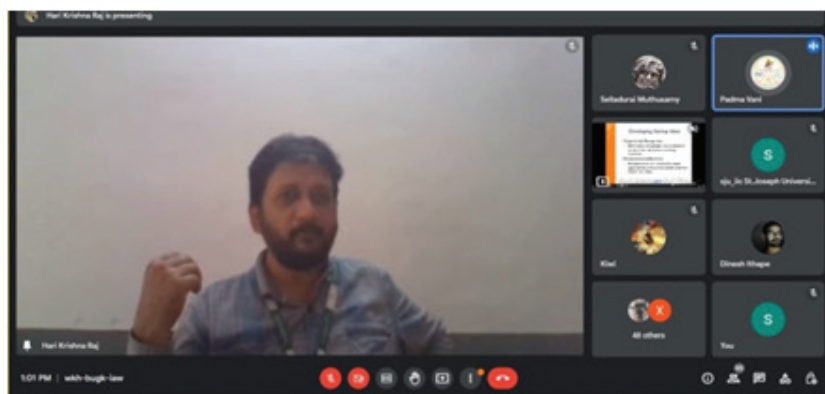
St Joseph University organized a 3-day Freshers' Induction Programme for the undergraduate students from 20th to 22nd July 2022.

NAAC ORIENTATION PROGRAM

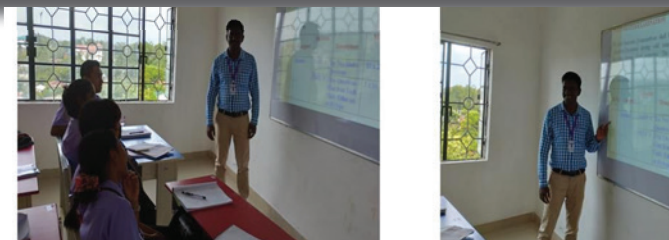

DEPARTMENT OF BIOTECHNOLOGY

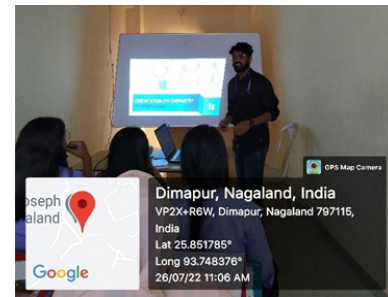
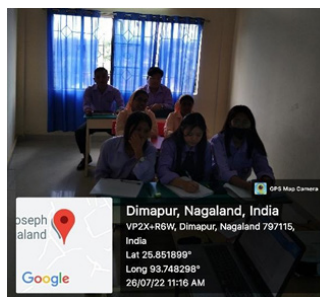
