Objective

The course aims to build complete LSRW proficiency and professional communication skills using digital tools and language lab software. Students will improve pronunciation, vocabulary, and comprehension, gain confidence in conversations, interviews, and presentations, and develop soft skills like teamwork, time management, and leadership to meet academic and workplace demands.

1. *Active Listening Log*: Listen to a 5-minutes TED talk, note key ideas, speaker's tone, and new vocabulary. Submit audio summary with notes.
2. *Pronunciation Drill*: Use sounds of English app to practice 20 minimal pairs. Record before/after pronunciation and submit both files.
3. *Role-Play Conversation*: Perform a 3-minute paired dialogue on a given academic/professional situation using language lab software. Submit recording.
4. *News Comprehension Test*: Read a news article on app, answer 10 MCQs on app, and record a 1-minute oral summary. Submit screenshot with audio.
5. *Grammarly & Hemingway Task*: Write a 200-word email/paragraph, edit using both tools, submit original, edited version, and readability scores.
6. *Prompt Writing*: Respond to a given prompt in 250 words within 20 minutes. Submit typed file with word count.
7. *Vocabulary Builder*: Complete 3 levels on V2 app. Submit 15 new words with meaning, sentences, and audio pronunciation.
8. *Formal Email Writing*: Draft a professional email for a given scenario. Check tone on Grammarly and submit final version with score.
9. *Report Writing*: Prepare a one-page report on a given topic using Hemingway Editor. Submit PDF with readability grade.
10. *Resume Creation*: Design a one-page resume on Canva for a specified job role. Submit PDF and 1-minute self-introduction video.
11. *Time Management Plan*: Create a weekly academic task plan on Trello/ToDoist. Submit screenshot and 1-minute audio explaining your priorities.
12. *Group Discussion*: Participate in a 5-minute recorded GD on language lab software on a current topic. Submit video with peer roles.
13. *Mock Interview*: Attend 5-minutes mock interview via language lab software. Submit video with evaluation sheet.
14. *PPT with visuals*: Create a 5-slide PPT on Google Slides/Canva with infographics. Record a 3-minute presentation using screen-record. Submit video.
15. *Body Language and Voice*: Deliver a 2-minute speech focusing on posture, gesture, and voice modulation. Record via language lab software with camera on. Submit video with peer feedback form.

Submission note: As part of the course requirement, students must complete and submit any 8 practicals out of the 15 listed. All files should be clearly named **RegNo_PracticalNo_Name** and compile in a digital portfolio or record book for assessment and evaluation.
